Mill Hollow Christmas Trees

We took our family to Mill Hollow Christmas Tree Farm over the Thanksgiving holiday and were pleasantly surprised by what we saw and experienced. This unique place is right across the street from Waterwood's 190 entrance. Take a left on 190 and an immediate right and you are at their entrance.



The farm was purchased by Denny and Marge Gunia in 1983. It is on the site of the old Oakhurst Saw Mill. The area is very scenic. It is located on top of a high hill. It is surrounded by forests and running creeks. The farm land consists of 84 acres with 20 acres planted in Christmas trees.



The "Choose and cut" operations at Mill Hollow were started in 1988. You buy the trees based on quality and not on size. There are thousands to pick from. The staff is friendly and visit is unforgettable.

Mill Hollow is not just for buying Christmas trees. The whole operation has been established for families to enjoy the country atmosphere while looking at the wonderful tree farm. There are many things to do: see a log cabin play house; play around a real tree house; "Tire Rolling" games; Trail Maze and a wonderful hay rack ride.



All of these amenities are free. There are even free hot dogs and trimmings available. You can even roast a marshmallow. The farm opened on Friday, November 23 and will be open every weekend in December thru Sunday, December 18. Gates are open from 10AM till 5PM.
