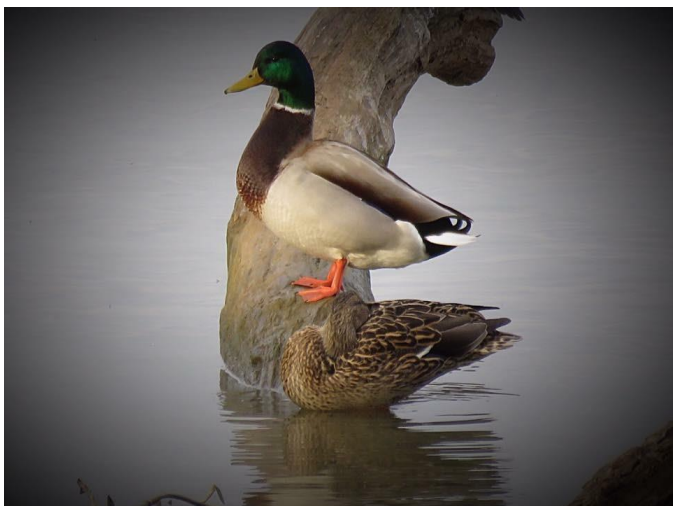

YARD DEBRIS PICK UP

Yard debris pick up is every Monday. WIA's maintenance crew will pick up yard debris that is placed curbside. The crew will pick up limbs, debris and bagged leaves. Limbs should not be larger than 4" diameter. You may take limbs larger than 4" diameter to the debris dump yourself. Please call security to open the gate to obtain access to the area. Commercial services must remove all debris that they cut.

Also, on the first Monday of every month there is an appliance and large item curb pickup. Contact the WIA office in advance to inform them of the item you want picked up and we will work to assist you.
