The Waterwood new redevelopment parties met in early May to discuss the future. It was reported that "progress is being made."

A source for new equipment to be used on the course has been found. Steve Morrell advised, "We will be getting some additional equipment on a loan basis to do some greens work. We will have access to an aerator to punch the greens to allow deeper watering, fertilization, air flow, pest control, and sanding. We will also be supplied with a new greens mower also on loan."

WNN was advised "There is a major water leak on #18 fairway. The water was shut off and the area is drying. When it gets a bit drier we will work on that issue." We will Keep YOU updated
