The Waterwood Boat club met April 18th at Justin and Dona Curren's home. Tom McDonough who represents the Lake Livingston Friend of the Reservoir organization, LLFoR, an effort has been made to plant American Water Willow plants along the shore line which will do several things:

- 1) Help stop erosion
- 2) Increase water filtration so visibility is better
- 3) Increase small animals like frogs and snakes
- 4) Increase bird habitat
- 5) And increase cover for fish who need a hiding place from larger fish

In addition, when this is completed, they hope it will increase visitors to the area and bring back the

fishing tournaments, both of which would generate millions of

dollars in revenue for the area. WBC Members have donated \$780 to Lake Livingston Friend of the Reservoir for the purchase of a plant tank.

THANK YOU TO ALL.

The purpose of this letter is to thank you one and all for your response to our request of March 26th regarding the boats and trailers at the marina and in the old rv park. The marina parking lot is now mostly cleared out except for the authorized property of the Bass Boat Villagers which has been moved to the far end. We are still hoping to reach the owners of a couple of trailers that sit along the shorefront but for the most part your tremendous cooperation has facilitated reaching our goal of cleaning up the area and we are grateful.

I have received a number of e-mails from you regarding this issue but due to the rather large stroke I suffered on April 12th and my subsequent surgery I have not responded. Please forgive me for that. Unfortunately I do not have a solution to the storage issue. Mr. Dominic Tijerina, the president of the Bass Boat Village POA demonstrated great leadership by moving his boat and trailer to a rental storage facility nearby. I think it is clear to most that Waterwood National Resort has no obligation to provide storage for anyone except as it chooses to do so and this policy will remain in effect for the foreseeable future.

At this juncture, as the problem has been solved, we do not intend to dispose of any of the equipment remaining in the marina area. There are, however, a few unidentified pieces that are long out of registration and our request to have them registered and moved stands. We thank you in advance for that.
