The MUD Board of Directors has contracted with a new management firm to handle the daily operation of our water and sewer treatment plants. **The Water Company** owned and operated by Berry and Donnie Duke will start managing Waterwood MUD #1 on April 1, 2012.

The MUD Board held its February meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup>. The Board accepted the resignation of long time member, Betty Jo Horn. Mr. Chris Jakobson was elected to fill the vacancy.

The newly elected officers are: President-Dick Hansen, Vice President-John Charlton, and Secretary-Willie Wiginton.

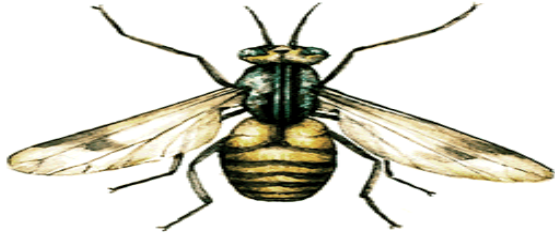


The Board voted effective April 1, 2012, to reduce the minimum water rate by **\$10.00** a month. The new rate will be \$4.50 for the first 2000 gallons of water used. Water usage over 2000 gallons will be billed at \$2.00 per 1000 gallons used. This \$2.00 is the same rate that has been charged in the past.

The sewer rate will remain at its current rate of \$11.00 per month.
