Waterwood's Telephone Service

On May 7, 1974 the Waterwood Telephone Company opened its doors for business. The original switching unit was a World War II "cross-bar" switch that was mounted on a tractor trailer van.

The phone lines and TV cable lines were laid by a sub-contractor for SHECO who laid these lines with the electric cables all at one time.



The current "phone" office/building was built in the mid 1980s. Roger Honea, our Customer Service Technician remembers pulling cable into the new switching station. Roger has been with the "phone" company since 1978.

Roger has watched our little phone company grow and change hands over the past thirty years. Waterwood Communications was bought by Sugarland Telephone in the mid 1980s.

New Yard Debris Pick up Program

The WIA Maintenance Committee has proposed a new yard debris pick up test program for the Waterwood community starting in December.

Our Maintenance contractor will pick up bagged leaves, tied twigs and small limbs every Monday. The WIA resident must take the yard debris to the curb and call the WIA office for pick up.

The WIA number is **891-7710**. This number is handled by an answering machine when the office is closed.

General rules provide that nothing other than yard debris will be picked up. Any garbage, paper and/or trash will not be handled by this new service.

If you place garbage on the street, varmints may break the bags and spread the garbage around the street. The resident will be responsible for cleaning up the mess.

It is recommended that large, (at least 30 gallon) sturdy plastic bags be used for the leaves. The bag should be tied and placed at the curb.

To keep these bags from becoming an eyesore, it is recommended that the bags and other debris be placed on the curbs on the weekends.

County Voting Results

There were major upsets in the San Jacinto county general election this month. Sheriff Lacy Rogers was upset by James Lewis Walters. The official voting results were Walters – 4,508 to Rogers 4,338. Rogers had been sheriff for twenty years. Sheriff-elect Walters has spent over 24 years with the Harris county sheriff's office.

Precinct 1 Commissioner Michael Griffith was beaten by Laddie McAnally. McAnally received 1,014 votes to Griffith's 915 votes.

Precinct 3 Commissioner David Brandon was defeated by James Moody 1471 to 970.

There were a total of 9,077 ballots cast in the county. 2,296 Republicans voted straight party ballots while 1,686 Democrats hit the straight "D" key.

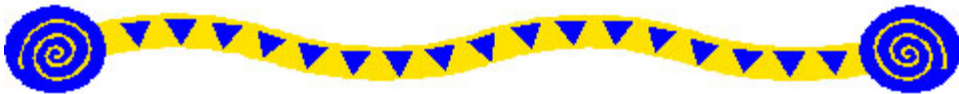
This photo was taken on the afternoon of 9/13/08, as Hurricane Ike was passing.
