WIA Board Meeting 4/20/09

President Jack Zimmermann called the April **WIA** Board meeting to order at 9:00AM. All Directors were present and 14 guests were in the audience.

Executive Director Joe Moore advised the board that he is in correspondence with "Cap Source Bank" and NRPI relative to the fees owed **WIA**.

Mr. Moore also stated that he has submitted documentation to San Jacinto County for debris removal reimbursement by FEMA.

The ACB Chairman, John Charlton reported three violation letters had been mailed and one verbal violation contact had been made. The ACB approved three Small Improvement Project Applications for the month.

Maintenance Chair, Janas Goldsmith advised the board there was a lot of mulch left at the debris dump. Mowing of the Waterwood streets and right of ways was discussed.

The board voted that the Parkway **right of way** owned by **WIA** from the burn dump to FM 980 be mowed when the Maintenance Committee Chair confirms all wildflowers have bloomed and gone to seed.

Another motion approved was not to mow the Parkway **right of way** owned by **WIA** from the burn dump to the former Lehtonen property. The board asked the Executive Director to contact the County about mowing that part of the Parkway.

The board also voted to mow the **right of way** along the interior streets inside of Waterwood on or about April 15 annually. All motions relative to mowing were **passed unanimously** by the board.

After an executive session the board meeting was adjourned at 12:31PM
