

# ***Waterwood Community PAVILION Rules***

24501 Waterwood Parkway

Regular Hours: 6:00 AM to 9:00 PM

## ***In Case of Emergency, Call 911 – Emergency Telephone Located in the Pavilion Sink Area***

1. Persons using the pavilion do so at their own risk. The Waterwood Improvement Association (WIA) is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or death.
2. The pavilion is for the exclusive use of Waterwood property owners who are in good standing, their tenants and their invited guests.
3. Use of the pavilion for a large private event (over 30 people) must be scheduled with the Waterwood Improvement Office (WIA) at least 7 days in advance. The reservation is for the pavilion only; the swimming pool and playground remain open to other users. The pavilion may not be reserved for private parties during holiday weekends.
4. Pavilion must be left in the same condition as existed prior to usage.
5. Use only removable tape to install decorations. Nails, tacks, or staples should not be used. Decorations must be removed after usage of the pavilion.
6. All trash must be placed in plastic bags in trash cans. Overflow trash must be removed from the park and can be deposited in the WIA trash dumpsters.
7. Fires can only be made in the park cooking grills. Extinguish all grills/hot coals before leaving.
8. No pets allowed in the pavilion.
9. No smoking or public intoxication allowed in or around the pavilion area.
10. No weapons or any other hazardous items are permitted in the pavilion.
11. No glass containers allowed in the pavilion.
12. Pavilion users must refrain from any activity which is a nuisance to other persons in the area.
13. Noise levels must be kept to an acceptable level.
14. Violations of these rules may result in temporary suspension of member privileges, fines or assessments and/or legal action against the violator(s).
15. If you are asked to leave the pavilion or park by a representative of WIA (security, employee or Board member) you must do so immediately.
