

WATERWOOD COMMUNITY POOL

Each property within the Association will be allowed to be in possession of **1 (one)** pool access card. The first card for each property is free. **Replacement cards are \$75.00 each.**

All property owners and tenants are required to complete and/or have on file the Pool Waiver and Pool Rules forms to obtain pool access. Waiver and Pool Rules forms can be picked up at the WIA office.

****To acquire a Pool Access Card**

Requirements A property owner must be current on all dues with a zero balance prior to issuance/activation of a pool access card for either the property owner or their tenant.

Property owners may obtain an access card at the WIA office. Bring a **current driver's license** and complete the Pool Waiver and Pool Rules forms to pick up your card.

In order for a tenant to access the pool, a Pool Waiver and Pool Rules form must be signed by both the property owner and the tenant. **Tenants will need to bring a current driver's license, a copy of the lease agreement, and the Waiver and Pool Rules form that is already signed by the property owner.** Tenants will also be required to sign the Waiver and the Pool Rules form.

****Pool Access card is not working**

If your Pool Access card is not working, please contact the WIA office at 936-891-7710 and provide your name, address, phone number, and card number in order to determine its status.

In the event the individual(s) are juveniles, the parents shall assume full responsibility for their child's actions. The Board of Directors will consider individual events.
