

Waterwood Community Pool Rules

24501 Waterwood Parkway

Regular Pool Hours: 6:00 AM to 9:00 PM

THE COST OF A POOL CARD IS \$75.00

In Case of Emergency, Call 911 – Emergency Telephone Located in Park Pavilion Sink Area

1. Persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The Waterwood Improvement Association (WIA) is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or death.
2. The pool is for the exclusive use of Waterwood Property Owners who are in good standing, their tenants and their invited guests.
3. Maximum pool capacity is 90 persons.
4. The association may deny access to or close the pool area to anyone at any time.
5. The WIA Office (936-891-7710) must be notified of any organized activity to take place in the pool area at least seven (7) days prior to the event or if the pool is to be used outside of regular pool hours..
6. Persons under fourteen (14) years of age must be accompanied by an adult who is eighteen (18) years of age or older at all times.
7. Pool gate(s) must be closed and locked at all times. Under no circumstances should the gate(s) be propped open.
8. Pool users are responsible for any damage they cause while using WIA facilities and for cleaning up any mess or trash created by them prior to leaving the pool area.
9. Pool users must refrain from any activity which is a nuisance to other persons in the area.
10. Children who are not “potty-trained” must wear a swim diaper while in the pool.
11. Lap swimmers have priority use of the lap lane.
12. Toys, balls, and floating devices are allowed in the pool.
13. No food or drink allowed inside the pool or within three (3) feet of the pool.
14. No pets, glass containers, weapons or any other hazardous items permitted inside the pool fenced area.
15. No running, roughhousing, horseplay, or disorderly conduct is permitted in or around the pool area.
16. No diving, somersaults, cannonballs, preacher seats, or similar entries into the pool are permitted.
17. No bikes, scooters, skateboards, roller skates/blades or similar items are permitted in the pool area.
18. No smoking, profanity, or public intoxication allowed in or around the pool area or in the park.
19. Violations of these rules may result in temporary suspension of member privileges, fines or assessments, and/or legal action against the violator(s).
20. If you are asked to leave the pool area or park by a representative of WIA (security, employee, or Board member) you must do so immediately.
